## 1.0 UPDATE

Friends of the Moor has suffered from a lack of volunteers and as such has been a little inactive in the past few months. A new committee has been appointed and our next meeting is place for late June.

We are planning to install seating into the shelter, this is being funded from the proceeds of the CoOp community fund. We had submitted a grant to Cheshire East Council's New Homes Bonus Fund for a trim trail but this was rejected so we will be exploring options for this.

We were extremely grateful to receive almost £3,500 from Cllr Coan's civic fundraising and have a number of potential projects that it could be put towards including the installation of additional seating, planting more flowers, trees or shrubs and potentially a trim trail.

Thanks to a new volunteer on the committee we are able to bring back the Play Day event which takes place on the first Wednesday in August; it was last held in 2016.

We hope to undertake a survey of users of the Moor to identify their priorities for improvements over the next years.
