Subject: Longridge Noticeboard

1.0 BACKGROUND

Cllr McCulloch and the Town Clerk met with the manager of The Welcome to discuss how the town council can increase access to council information and awareness in the Longridge area.

It was noted that the Welcome already has a number of internal noticeboards and the manager felt it was not feasible to add to this but that an external noticeboard would be the best route forward.

The suggested location for the noticeboard is on the small green opposite the Welcome which is also close to the Falcon Bearer public house and neighbourhood shops.

A noticeboard would provide a space for the town council to publicise information about the council such as what it does, how it can help residents and providing contact information for the Over ward councillors. It would help distinguish between the town and borough council and depending on size it could also display general community information and event posters.

The noticeboard would be kept up-to-date by the Town Ranger.

3.0 BUDGET

The committee has a street furniture budget of £2,500 (330/4200). The spend to date (£3,049) includes £2595



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on the town centre maps which were fully funded by sponsorship (330/1315) leaving an available budget of £2,046.

Installation is anticipated to be in the region of £200 and would be drawn from the External Contractors budget (£3,400, 330/4180).

4.0 DECISIONS REQUIRED

The committee should consider the installation of a noticeboard at Longridge.



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
