WARREN AVENUE FENCE REPLACEMENT

1.0 BACKGROUND

At a meeting with the Knutsford Allotment Society, the Society has requested that the council renew the fencing around the allotment track at the Warren Avenue allotments. The existing fencing pre-dates the transfer of the allotments and is reaching the end of its life in many places. The fence forms the boundary of the allotment plots and the track which runs through the centre of the site.

The fence is a cleft chestnut pale fence extending approx. 215m. The cost for the materials to replace the fence is £1,590. The work would be undertaken by the Town Ranger over the coming months.

The committee has a budget of £330 remaining in the current year allotments budget and £1,056 in the 2021/22 financial year budget. The council further has £4,237 in the EM Allotments Reserve, built up from the rents received since transfer.

2.0 DECISION REQUIRED

The committee should consider the approval of the works.
