Identify further areas for wildflower/pollinator planting	Some additional areas were identified and will be implemented from the autumn
Agree a plan with Crown Estate for the improvement of wildlife corridor wildlife corridor C-001 from Bluebell Wood to the Heath	The Crown Estate has agreed to plant a double hedge and trees along the field edge from Bluebell Wood to the open space at the Tabley Park Site.
Engage with landowners to make enhancements and improvements to the wildlife corridors C-004 and C-019 from Booths Mere to St Johns Wood.	Proposals incorporated in committee report.
Plant a hedge and wildflower meadow around the edge of the Boothfields/Longridge open space to enhance corridor C-004 from Booths Mere to St Johns Wood	Proposals incorporated in committee report.
Create a 'bee trail' connecting the major wildflower areas	The bee trail was launched in May. Some signage remains outstanding and will be installed in the coming weeks and further enhancement along the route and promotion of the trail will continue.
Install an information board at the Barncroft wildflower meadow	The board is currently being designed.
Install bee boxes	A number will be installed along the bee trail within the next few weeks.
